



Meeting Minutes Nov. 11, 2021

President Jim Burns Called the meeting to order at 6:15 PM. Members present were Lynn Shively, Tom Walters, Dick Goodfellow, Mike Kirk, Kevin Shaw, and Jim Burns.

Old Business: Jim handed out the minutes from our last meeting. The minutes were approved.

New Business: Jim reserved Riverwalk Park for our show next year. He also filled out an application for a county grant, but the county turned us down, mainly because we give out scholarships. Jim also filled out an application with the Lake Chelan Chamber for a grant. We should find out in a couple of months if we will receive one.

Jim sent in the artwork for the t-shirts. He wants to get the artwork done so we can use it in any advertising we do. Mike said he would like it for the web site also.

Jim and Jolene drove around and looked at all the wineries as a possible replacement for Friday night registration at Miller's Museum. We paid \$450 for the rental of Miller's Museum last year. We need to decide what we are going to do, so we can start to advertise the show. Kevin asked what people would like to do for registration, go to a winery or go to the car museum. Consensus was the car museum. Kevin volunteered to help Jim talk to Leo about getting a better rate on the car museum.

Consensus was that we will raise the entry fee to our car show to \$35. Jim will start to talk with Griots, Summit Racing, and Rock Auto about donations for our goody bags. The DJ has been reserved for next year. Jim said he would like help

getting a better price on the car show dash plaques. We paid \$3 apiece for 120 dash plaques last year. Tom recommended that we do more goody bags for next show. Jim said let's do 150 for the next show. Jim suggested we do an honorable Phil Rock Trophy for next show.

Jim was wondering if we could get an active PDF writer (fill in the form) and take credit cards on the web site. Mike said that it would cost us about a dollar to process each credit card, as well as an annual fee for the software. Mike will spend some time choosing the software and getting prices.

Jim will prepare a spread sheet for next meeting to look at future costs, so we can determine how much money we might have for a scholarship award. Jim will visit the County Line this weekend to collect our show donation. We will keep our membership fee at \$25. Mike asked if anyone would like to volunteer to have their car featured for the "featured car corner" on the web site. Kevin will send him some info on his build. Mike brought up the idea of a car club banquet. Jim volunteered to have a car club dinner at his place. The dinner date was tentatively set for Jan. 15th.

Mike would like to get the schools more involved in the scholarship selections. Maybe we could have Chelan and Manson high schools give us up to 3 candidates for the scholarship, so we could vote on them. Both Jim and Kevin said that Mike should talk to Bob Goedde about it, because he has been handling the scholarship selections.

Treasurer's Report: We have \$7500 dollars in checking and savings after all the bills were paid.
