



Meeting Minutes July 20, 2022

Old Business: The meeting minutes from last meeting were approved.

Mike and Jeffrey have volunteered to cook burgers for a donation price at the Friday night event. Mike asked if anyone had a portable grill that we could use. Two people volunteered, and we will talk more about it at the next meeting. We took a voice vote, and we decided to have only hamburgers (No brats), small bag of chips and a soda, or water. Tom asked about serving Potato Salad. After discussion, Mike said he would investigate it. Mike asked Dick if he would volunteer to help serve food. He said yes, and several members said that they

would also volunteer their wives. We decided that we would have 60 servings of food and plenty of soda and water that we could also sell at the show if we have leftovers. Coke, Pepsi, and diet Coke were the preferred sodas. We will need coolers for the water, sodas, meat, potato salad, and cheese slices.

Jim asked Tom about the banner for Campbell's fence. Tom said we can put it up 2 weeks ahead of time. Mike said that we have received the car club hats. He said that they cost us a little under \$25 per hat and asked how much we want to charge for them. It was decided that we would charge \$20 to car club members, and \$30 to nonmembers.

Jim said that we should have another cruise in Chelan and Manson, maybe at a winery. It was suggested that Benson Winery has plenty of Parking. Fielding Hills is another winery with good parking. Jim will make some calls.

Kevin asked if there was interest in starting up the rendezvous again? After discussions, it was decided that we would start Thursdays night, July 27th at the Apple Cup in Chelan.

Our next meeting will be Thursday, the 25th of August at Mark's shop at 4:30 PM. At the next meeting we will be discussing parking people, judges, help for set up, and create a parking plan for the park. Kevin suggested that we have the parking meeting at the park. Kevin, Lynn, Mike, and Chris will be the parking attendants.

Treasurers Report: We have about \$2500 checking and \$3000 in savings, but we owe Mike about \$600 for the hats, and Leo Miller has not cashed his \$400 check. So, we have about approximately \$4500. Jim asked about things we still need to spend money on. We need about \$300 in cash for the show. We need to make a second half payment for the shirts. We already paid them \$1000. Lynn just deposited money for 10 preregisters at the bank. We are up to 29 or 30 preregisters, including 7 credit card registrations. Jim said that we are in pretty good shape.
